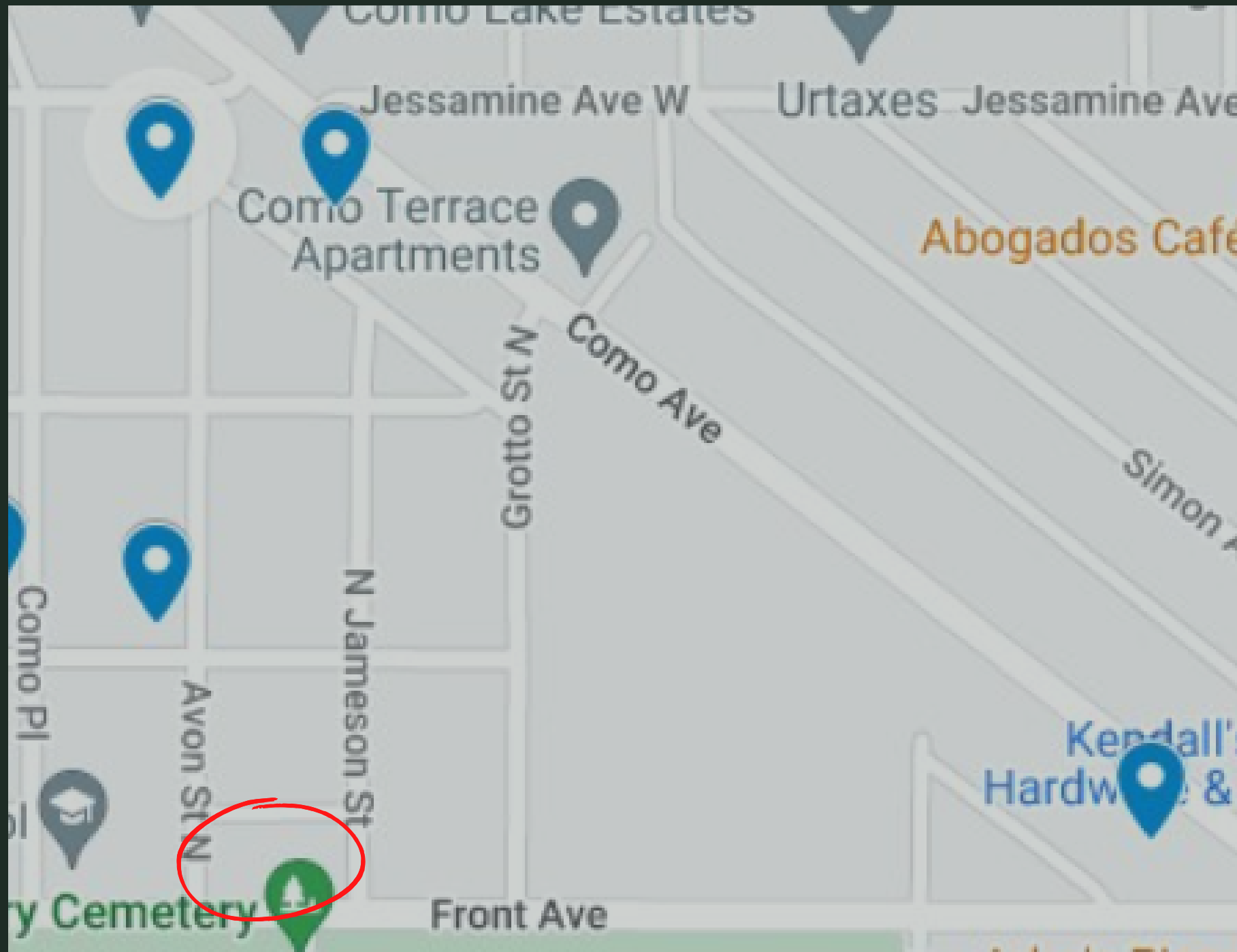


Lawns to Legume Grant Pieces

Jameson/Front Lot History

- Contaminated by improperly stored chemicals by Ecolotech between 1973-1984
 - Minnesota Pollution Control Agency clean happened between 1984-1997
 - Removed from the Superfund List (now called a "cleaned up Superfund site")
 - Remained vacant since then (besides a bench and the sidewalk that runs through it)

Jameson/Front Lot History

- Como Community Council reached out to MCPA regarding a possible community garden
 - Saint Paullinators reached out about a pocket prairie and were approved for native plants
 - Ramsey County approved a native planting
 - Working with Metro Blooms to design up to a \$15,000 installation (funds pending)
- 



Funding

- \$5,000 from Lawns to Legume Demonstration Neighborhood
 - \$3,000 overflow from Residential Plantings (pending approval)
 - \$3,000 from CRWD Grant (pending application)
 - TBD from potential research grants with the University of Minnesota
